<b>Project Description</b>	<p>The purpose of this project is to improve traffic operations, enhance safety of this intersection, and to be consistent with traffic associated with existing and planned local development.</p> <p>The project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Excavating for roadway widening and construction of drainage facilities;</li> <li>• Placing lighting and signals;</li> <li>• Installing a signal-controlled intersection with sidewalk and accessibility improvements, signage and striping, and lighting;</li> <li>• Widening the road so that all lanes are 12-feet wide with a 4-8 foot shoulder; and</li> <li>• Relocating the drainage ditch, headwalls and pipes in the southeast quadrant of the intersection to accommodate road widening.</li> </ul> <p>No compensatory mitigation is planned for this project.</p> <p>The California Department of Transportation filed a (Mitigated) Negative Declaration.</p>
