All businesses/operations that produce commercial irrigated crop(s) must file an electronic Notice of Intent (eNOI) with the Water Board:

1- Growers who HAVE NOT submitted the eNOI must do so, before October 3, 2011.

2- Growers who HAVE ALREADY submitted the eNOI should review and/or update their operation and ranch information before October 15, 2011.

Prior to making an appointment, growers are encouraged to access the eNOI by doing the following:

1. **COLLECT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- AW Number
- Operation contact Information (name, address, and phone number)
- Landowner contact information (name, address, phone number's)
- All associated assessors parcel numbers (APN)
- Ranch contact information (name, address, and phone number) for each ranch
- Date of last Farm Plan update
- Farm water quality education completion
- Ranch map(s) and location(s)
- Irrigated acreage and total tailwater acres
- Irrigation type(s) and crop type(s)
- Name of any waterbody(s) adjacent to farm/ranch
- Pesticide permit number, including Site ID

3. Choose **New eNOI Users** (if you have never submitted information online) or **Returning eNOI user** (if you submitted the information electronically and received a temporary username and password in a Water Board letter).

4. **RETURNING eNOI USERS – enter temporary “username” and “password” provided in letter.**

5. Once you have logged in to the site, review and update the information about your operation and each individual ranch/farm to ensure it is complete and accurate.
