3. There is no evidence offered by RWQBC to show that my septic tank has violated Resolution 83-13.
4. The RWOCB violated my Due Process Rights throughout the CDO process.
5. The use of CDOs against individuals is unprecedented, discriminatory and unconstitutional.

I will attend the hearing and present my limited defense. I do not have the expertise to dispute any scientific material therefore, I should not be held responsible for a rebuttal on this matter.
