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NOTICE OF TERMINATION FOR GENERAL ORDER NO. R5-2015-0012-077, IN-SITU GROUNDWATER REMEDIATION AND DISCHARGE OF TREATED GROUNDWATER TO LAND, FORMER DELTA CLEANERS, 219 OAK STREET, BRENTWOOD, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

On 11 October 2022, the Executive Officer of the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board) issued a Notice of Applicability under Order No. R5-2015-0012, Waste Discharge Requirements General Order for Insitu Groundwater Remediation and Discharge of Treated Groundwater to Land for the Former Delta Cleaners site. In the Notice of Applicability, the project was assigned site-specific Order No. R5-2015-0012-077.

The in-situ groundwater remediation consisted of injecting 44,400 pounds of 3DMicroemulson electron donor, 10,000 pounds of Sulfidated Micro Zero Valent Iron suspension and 129 pounds of Bio-Dechlor Inoculum plus bacteria culture into groundwater using direct-push technology at 85 injection points to treat concentrations of tetrachloroethene (PCE) and its breakdown products. The injections took place between 18 October 2022 and 16 November 2022. No further injections are planned for this site. Continued groundwater monitoring is being conducted under a separate agreement. Therefore, it is appropriate to terminate enrollment.
