ORDER NO R5-2009-0024

RESCINDING NPDES PERMIT

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, finds that the Board adopted the following Order that is no longer needed for the reason below.

WDRs Order No. R5-2003-0171 (NPDES Permit No. CA0083798) prescribes requirements for discharges from the California Department of Forestry And Fire Protection (Cal-Fire), Mountain Home Conservation Camp, wastewater treatment facility to land and to Bear Creek, a water of the United States. Cal-Fire has eliminated the discharge to Bear Creek and requested rescission of Order No. R5-2003-0171. Discharges to land will be covered under State Water Board *Water Quality Order No. 97-10-DW. General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land by Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems*, Order No. R5-2003-0171 is no longer necessary and should be rescinded. (DAB)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above NPDES Permit be rescinded.
