

**COUNTY OF PLACER DEPARTMENT OF FACILITY SERVICES,
FORESTHILL LANDFILL, CLASS III LANDFILL, POST-CLOSURE
MAINTENANCE AND MONITORING, Placer County (update)**

The Foresthill Landfill is a closed, unlined landfill approximately two miles southwest of Foresthill. The 4-acre landfill operated from 1966 to 1983 accepting primarily household waste, construction debris, and green waste. The facility stopped accepting wastes in 1983 and was closed in 1984 with a soil cover. A new soil cover was installed in 1996 after erosion damaged the original cover. No groundwater impacts have been detected at the site to date. These updated WDRs prescribe requirements for post-closure maintenance and monitoring of the landfill. The monitoring and reporting program requires semiannual groundwater monitoring for specified parameters and minerals, monitoring every two years for volatile organic compounds, and monitoring every five years for all landfill constituents of concern. Surface drainage in the area is to Pond Creek which flows into the Middle Fork of the American River. (JDM)
