AMENDMENTS TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE SACRAMENTO
RIVER AND SAN JOAQUIN RIVER BASINS FOR THE CONTROL OF DIAZINON AND
CHLORPYRIFOS RUNOFF INTO THE SACRAMENTO-SAN JOAQUIN DELTA




Footnotes:
