**PUBLIC HEARING**

**CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
(NPDES NO. CA0084620)  
AND TIME SCHEDULE ORDER**  
for  
**CALAVERAS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT  
COPPER COVE WASTEWATER RECLAMATION FACILITY  
SADDLE CREEK GOLF COURSE, L.P.  
CALAVERAS COUNTY**

Calaveras County Water District and Saddle Creek Golf Course L.P. (Dischargers) applied for a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit authorization to discharge tertiary treated reclaimed wastewater from Copper Cove Wastewater Reclamation Facility on Saddle Creek Golf Course and to its jurisdictional wetlands tributary to Littlejohns Creek. The proposed NPDES permit allows a discharge up to 0.95 million gallon per day of UV disinfected tertiary treated effluent into a recycled water storage reservoir for use on a restricted section of the Saddle Creek golf course. When necessary, this permit also regulates a direct discharge of tertiary treated effluent to a federally regulated wetlands to provide makeup water, and considers incidental run-off of tertiary treated wastewater to the wetlands and Littlejohns Creek that could occur during the first rainstorm or as part of any nominal reclaimed wastewater uses. The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) include effluent limitations considering Department of Health reclamation criteria and a proposed Time Schedule Order (TSO) provides time schedules to come into compliance with the new WDRs.

A formal public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Water Board meeting which is scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Calaveras County Water District
- Saddle Creek Golf Course, L.P.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting

such request in writing to the Board no later than **5 July 2006**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements and Time Schedule Order were issued on **26 May 2006**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item must submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **1 July 2006**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **1 July 2006** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
