**Time Schedule and Cease and Desist Order**

**MADISON COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT  
YOLO COUNTY**

Madison Community Services District owns and operates a municipal wastewater treatment facility (WWTF) in Madison, Yolo County. Madison CSD has not complied with Amended Cease and Desist Order No. 94-062 adopted in March 2000 and does not have sufficient storage and disposal capacity to prevent discharges of waste to surface waters. Regional Water Board staff is proposing a combined Time Schedule and Cease and Desist Order that would require Madison CSD to expand the facility as needed to comply with the March 2000 Amended CDO and to complete other work to improve WWTF performance and capacity.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Board meeting, which is scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of Central Valley Regional Board
- Madison Community Services District

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **8 March 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Time Schedule and Cease and Desist Order was issued on 20 December 2006. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **8 March 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **8 March 2007** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
