Sims Hugo Neu and El Dorado Property Management (hereafter jointly referred to as "Discharger") are owners of the Cove Contractors Landfill, Inc., located at 3200 and 3242 South El Dorado Street, Stockton, in San Joaquin County. The facility is an unlined landfill on 11.2 acres that was operated until 1988. As a result of Cleanup and Abatement Order No. R5-2006-0707, the Discharger is constructing a final cover for the landfill in compliance with Title 27 final cover requirements. These Waste Discharge Requirements include requirements for the detection monitoring, corrective action monitoring, and post-closure maintenance of the closed landfill.

A **formal** public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Water Board meeting which is scheduled for:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **24 May 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item must submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **24 May 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **24 May 2007** will not be

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accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
