LASSEN COUNTY

The County of Lassen owns the property where the Bieber Class III Municipal Solid Waste Landfill (Bieber Landfill) is located. The Lassen Regional Solid Waste Management Authority (LRSWMA) manages solid waste operations within Lassen County, including maintenance of the Bieber Landfill. The County of Lassen and the LRSWMA are collectively referred to as Dischargers. These Waste Discharge Requirements are being revised to require post-closure maintenance and corrective action monitoring at the landfill.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **1 November 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Written evidence or comments submitted after **1 November 2007** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
