RESCISSION OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. 5-00-247 FOR CITY OF MERCED WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY MERCED COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative Order rescinding Cease and Desist Order No. 5-00-247 for the Merced Wastewater Treatment Facility. The tentative Order will be considered for adoption by the Regional Water Board at its meeting scheduled for 13/14 March 2008. Persons wishing to comment on the tentative Order shall submit their evidence, testimony, and/or comments in writing to this office no later than by 5:00 p.m. on **30 January 2008**. Written materials shall be addressed to the attention of or emailed to W. Dale Harvey (dharvey@waterboards.ca.gov), and if emailed, a printed and signed copy must be mailed and postmarked by the final date and time. Written materials received after 5:00 p.m. on **30 January 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.
