CHARLES FULTON, CAROL FULTON, AND FULTON FAMILY TRUST
FOR OPERATION OF FULTON RECLAMATION INC.
GLENN COUNTY

Fulton Family Trust owns 315 acres approximately five miles south of the City of Orland. Charles and Carol Fulton reside on the property and operate a drilling mud recycling/soil amendment operation, Fulton Reclamation Inc., on the Fulton Family Trust land. These Waste Discharge Requirements are being revised to reflect the proposed drilling mud application rate increase, from 12 percent dry weight to 16 percent dry weight and to modify the monitoring and reporting program.

Persons wishing to comment on this matter must submit their testimony, evidence, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than 5 p.m. on **15 February 2008**. Written materials received after 5 p.m. on **15 February 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All interested persons may speak at the Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony will be limited in time by the Board Chair.

An objection by a party, either in writing or at the time of the hearing, to the decision to hold a hearing not allowing cross-examination and rebuttal testimony by designated parties shall be resolved by the Board Chair before going ahead under the proposed procedures. Failure to make a timely objection to the use of the proposed hearing procedure before those procedures are used will constitute consent to those procedures.
