The City of Roseville (hereinafter Discharger) is the owner and operator of the Dry Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) and the Pleasant Grove WWTP. The two treatment facilities provide sewerage service for the City of Roseville and portions of Placer County and the South Placer Municipal Utility District. The Dry Creek WWTP discharges tertiary treated wastewater to Dry Creek, a tributary to the Natomas East Main Drainage Canal, and further to the Sacramento River. Similarly, the Pleasant Grove WWTP discharges tertiary treated wastewater to Pleasant Grove Creek, tributary to the Pleasant Grove Creek Canal, Natomas Cross Canal, and the Sacramento River. The two tentative NPDES permit renewals propose new and more stringent effluent limitations and waste discharge requirements than those in existing Orders No. 5-00-164 and Order No. 5-00-075 for the Dry Creek WWTP and Pleasant Grove WWTP, respectively. Additionally, the tentative Time Schedule Orders propose time schedules for the Discharger to comply with proposed permit limitations for the two WWTPs.

The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and, in particular, how the person is directly affected by the discharge(s).

Persons wishing to comment on this hearing item must submit testimony, evidence, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on **5 May 2008**. Written evidence or comments submitted after 5:00 p.m. on **5 May 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
