GLENN COUNTY

Sulara Enterprises, Inc. owns and operates the Drilling Mud Disposal Facility (Facility), a closed landfill about one mile south of Orland, Glenn County. The Waste Discharge Requirements are being revised to require post-closure maintenance of the Facility and to implement applicable provisions of Title 27, California Code of Regulations.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Water Board meeting that is scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Sulara Enterprises, Inc.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **13 April 2009**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than 5 p.m. on **13 April 2009**. Written materials submitted after 5 p.m. on **13 April 2009** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
