NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
concerning

**RENEWAL OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (NPDES No. CA0077844)
AND RESCISSION OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. 93-068
FOR
CITY OF PORTOLA
PORTOLA WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT
PLUMAS COUNTY**

The City of Portola (Discharger) owns and operates the Portola Wastewater Treatment Plant, which provides treatment for up to 0.5 million gallons per day (mgd) of domestic wastewater from the community of Portola. The Facility discharges secondary treated wastewater to the Middle Fork of the Feather River, a water of the United States.

The Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) will consider renewal of the Discharger's existing NPDES permit, proposing new or more restrictive effluent limitations for BOD, TSS, ammonia, pH, copper, and electrical conductivity. The Discharger is able to immediately comply with the new effluent limitations. The Regional Water Board will also consider rescission of Cease and Desist Order No. 93-068.

On 21 May 1993, the Regional Water Board adopted Cease and Desist No. 93-068, which provided a time schedule for the Discharger to comply with overflows and excessive Infiltration and Inflow (I/I) by 1 February 1995. The Discharger completed construction of treatment plant upgrades to insure compliance with the Cease and Desist Order in the late 1990s. Although some I/I remains, as is the case with many wastewater treatment plants, substantial compliance has been achieved and the Cease and Desist Order is no longer needed.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Water Board meeting that is scheduled for:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as

a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on 13 May 2009**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements were issued on 10 April 2009. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on 13 May 2009**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **5:00 p.m. on 13 May 2009** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
