WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY  
COLUSA COUNTY**

The Maxwell Public Utilities District, hereinafter Discharger, is the owner and operator of the Wastewater Treatment Facility that provides sewerage service to the town of Maxwell. Treated wastewater is discharged to an unnamed tributary of Lurline Creek, a tributary to the Colusa Basin Drain. In June 2007 the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) adopted Time Schedule Order No. R5-2007-0073 (TSO) to provide a compliance schedule for pollutant limitations in Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. 2002-0022. In February 2009, the Central Valley Water Board renewed the 2002 WDR Order by adopting WDR Order No. R5-2009-0009. The proposed Order Amending the TSO is necessary to apply the existing compliance schedules to the recently adopted WDR Order No. R5-2009-009.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Central Valley Water Board meeting that is scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of Central Valley Regional Water Board
- Maxwell Public Utilities District staff

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **2 October 2009**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The proposed Order Amending the TSO was issued on **23 July 2009**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, and/or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than 5:00 pm on **30 August 2009**. Written evidence or comments must be limited to the scope of the proposed Amendment identified in "underline/strike-out" text in the tentative Order. Written evidence or comments outside the scope of the proposed revisions identified in "underline/strike-out" and/or submitted after 5:00 pm on **30 August 2009** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
