**TENTATIVE RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
ORDER NO. 5-01-092
FOR
PARADISE TOUCHLESS CARWASH
BUTTE COUNTY**

The Paradise Touchless Carwash (Discharger) owned and operated a carwash which produced up to 350 gallons per day (gpd) of waste water. The Facility discharges recycled waste water to 150 liner feet of leachfield trenches. The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) will consider rescission of the existing Waste Discharge Requirements for Order No. 5-01-092 as the carwash has been decommissioned and the facility converted to auto repair bays and storage.

On 27 April 2001, the Regional Water Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. 5-01-092 to regulate the discharge from a carwash which operated at the facility discharging recycled waste water to a leachfield. Based on a request received from the Discharger, dated 3 March 2010, and a site visit by Central Valley Water Board Staff on 31 July 2009, verifying that the facility was no longer in operation, the WDR Order is no longer required.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Water Board meeting that is scheduled for:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **noon on 30 April 2010**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **noon on 30 April 2010**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **noon on 30 April 2010** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
