SUBJECT: City of Antioch, City of Brentwood, City of Oakley, Contra Costa County and Contra Costa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District;  
Contra Costa County

BOARD ACTION: Consideration of Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) NPDES Permit Renewal

DISCUSSION: The Cities of Antioch, Brentwood, Oakley, Contra Costa County, and the Contra Costa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (Permittees) requested renewal of their NPDES permit to discharge storm water runoff from their MS4. The discharge consists of surface runoff generated from various land uses that discharge into storm drains, which in turn discharge to natural drainage watersheds. The major natural drainage watershed in the east Contra Costa County (CCC) urbanized area is Marsh Creek and associated tributaries. These water bodies discharge to the Sacramento-San Joaquin River Delta.

The CCC boundary encompasses two Regional Water Boards: the Central Valley Region (Region 5) and the San Francisco Bay Region (Region 2). The Permittees have requested the two Regional Boards provide an inter-region collaborative approach of collective activities through the Contra Costa Clean Water Program, including funding and budgeting, to be efficient and effective as possible. In this regard, the requirements in the tentative permit renewal incorporate proposed coordination with Region 2's Municipal Regional Permit (MRP) Order No. R2-2009-0074 with the exception of the implementation of TMDLs within the Central Valley Region.

ISSUES: This item is uncontested at this time

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the NPDES permit renewal.
