TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is tentative Waste Discharge Requirements for the Lake Oroville Marina LLC, Butte County. The revision specifies requirements for Lake Oroville Marina LLC, State of California Department of Parks and Recreation, and Department of Water Resources based on the facility concession contract. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the proposed Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 16 December 2010**. Written materials submitted after **5:00 p.m. on 16 December 2010** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative document will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its 2, 3, 4 February 2011 Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed.

By 15 November post one (1) copy of the Notice at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and,
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **30 November 2010**.

To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative documents to the discharger only. Interested persons are advised that the full text of the tentative documents is available on the Central Valley Water Board's web site at http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/centralvalley/board_decisions/tentative_orders/.
