PUBLIC HEARING
concerning

**REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR POST-CLOSURE AND CORRECTIVE ACTION**
of
**BUENA VISTA LANDFILL
AMADOR COUNTY**

Amador County owns Buena Vista Landfill, a closed municipal solid waste landfill, three miles south of Lone and one-half mile north of Buena Vista. The facility consists of three closed Solid Waste Management Units and an open Class II Surface Impoundment. Discharges to the Surface Impoundment are limited to landfill leachate and contaminated water generated on site. These Post-closure Waste Discharge Requirements prescribe post-closure maintenance requirements for the solid waste units, operation requirements for the surface impoundment and the corrective action program to remove volatile organic compounds from the vadose zone and from groundwater.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Board meeting which is scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of Central Valley Regional Board
- Amador County

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **15 June 2011**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative revised Waste Discharge Requirements were issued on 28 March 2011. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than by noon on **15 June 2011**. Written materials submitted after noon on **15 June 2011** will

not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
