**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

concerning

**TENTATIVE CEASE AND DESIST ORDER MODIFICATIONS**

**FOR**

**PLACER COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF FACILITY SERVICES  
PLACER COUNTY SEWER MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 3  
PLACER COUNTY**

The Placer County Department of Facility Services (hereafter Discharger) owns and operates Placer County Sewer Maintenance District No. 3, a wastewater collection and treatment system in Placer County. The treatment system currently discharges up to 0.3 million gallons per day of treated wastewater to Miners Ravine.

A tentative Cease and Desist Order requiring the Discharger to comply with requirements prescribed in Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2007-0070 was issued for public comment on 14 November 2011. The tentative Cease and Desist Order contained compliance schedules and interim limitations. The following modifications to a compliance schedule and interim limits have been made to the tentative Cease and Desist Order:

1. Final Approval Due Date for a Financing Plan was changed to 30 September 2012, and
2. Interim limitations were changed as shown in underline/strikethrough format below:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **27 January 2012**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and, in particular, how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Cease and Desist Order modifications were issued on 27 December 2011. Persons wishing to comment on the tentative modifications must submit testimony, evidence, and/or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on **27 January 2012**. Public comments must be limited to the scope of the tentative modifications. Written evidence or comments outside the scope of the tentative modifications and/or submitted after 5:00 p.m. on **27 January 2012** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
