TENTATIVE AMENDMENT TO GENERAL ORDER WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS R5-2004-0061 STOCKTON DEEP WATER SHIP CHANNEL MAINTENANCE DREDGING

Attached is the Notice of Public Hearing and proposed Amendment to General Order (GO) R5-2004-0061 Stockton Deep Water Ship Channel Maintenance Dredging. The proposed amendment clarifies the existing GO to permit the direct reuse of dredge material from maintenance dredging operations in the Stockton Deep Water Ship Channel at sites approved by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board.

The proposed amendment will be presented at the next public hearing of the Regional Board scheduled for 1-3 August 2012.
