FORWARD INC. AND REPUBLIC SERVICES INC.
SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

Republic Services Inc. as Forward Inc. owns and operates Forward Landfill, a Class II landfill near Manteca. Revised Waste Discharge Requirements address the following: incorporate recently purchased adjacent land into the landfill boundary, revise Leachate Collection and Removal System (LCRS) base grades, approve an alternative final cover design, update concentration limits and other monitoring parameters, update the monitoring network, revise soil pore gas monitoring requirements and incorporate new requirements for a composting operation.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Board meeting which is scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **24 September 2012**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements Order was issued on 23 July 2012. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than by noon on **4 September 2012**. Written materials submitted after noon on 4 September 2012 will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
