**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
concerning

TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
FOR  
L AND D LANDFILL LIMITED PARTNERSHIP  
FRUITRIDGE ROAD LAND COMPANY  
L AND D LANDFILL  
LIMITED CLASS III LANDFILL  
CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, CLOSURE, POST-CLOSURE MAINTENANCE,  
AND CORRECTIVE ACTION  
SACRAMENTO COUNTY

The waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the L and D Landfill are being revised to approve proposed engineered alternative final cover systems and to include information about a proposed increase in the final elevation of the landfill. The proposed final covers include, from bottom to top, a one-foot soil foundation layer, a 40-mil geomembrane, a geocomposite drainage layer, and a one-foot soil vegetative layer. The final cover for the lined landfill area additionally includes a geosynthetic clay liner beneath the geomembrane. The Discharger included the necessary engineered alternative demonstrations required by Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations. The tentative WDRs were circulated for public review, including a comment period that began on 28 March 2012 and closed on 30 April 2012. Comments were received from L and D Landfill Limited Partnership. The Board's consideration of the tentative WDRs was originally scheduled for the 7/8 June 2012 Board meeting, but consideration of the tentative WDRs was moved to the 4/5 October 2012 Board's meeting to give Sacramento County additional time to circulate and approve an Initial Study and a Negative Declaration for the project. No substantive provisions of the WDRs have changed due to this delay.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of Central Valley Water Board

- L and D Landfill Limited Partnership
- Fruitridge Road Land Company

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify are interested persons and not designated parties. All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
