ISSUANCE OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR UNIVAR USA INC. GROUNDWATER CLEANUP IN THE VICINITY OF 1152 G STREET, FRESNO, FRESNO COUNTY

Enclosed for review are tentative waste discharge requirements for Univar USA Inc. for insitu remediation of groundwater impacted by tetrachloroethene, a dry cleaning solvent, and associated volatile organic compounds. Also enclosed is a notice of public hearing (NOPH) to interested parties. The enclosed NOPH describes the date, time, and place that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is scheduled to have a hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative Resolution.
