Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the City of Tulare Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) in Tulare County. The tentative WDRs include a tentative Master Recycling Permit. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative WDRs at its 11/12 April 2013 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs must be submitted to this office by **5:00 pm on 28 February 2013**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.

In order to conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, a paper copy of the tentative WDRs has been sent to the Discharger only. Others are advised that the tentative WDRs are available on the Central Valley Water Board's website at:
