**TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:**

Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs)/NPDES permit (enclosed) for the City of Bakersfield and County of Kern Storm Water Discharges from the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System are available for public comment, as explained in the enclosed Notice of Public Hearing. To conserve resources, paper copies of the tentative WDRs/NPDES permit are being sent to the Dischargers only. The tentative WDRs/NPDES permit and any additional information is available electronically on the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board's (Central Valley Water Board) web site at:

The Central Valley Water Board has not reviewed or made any decision concerning the tentative WDRs/NPDES permit which may still be revised following the comment period. Revised documents along with comments and the staff responses will be posted on the above web site and placed in the Central Valley Water Board meeting agenda. The Central Valley Water Board will consider these and any appropriate oral testimony at the scheduled public hearing. The Central Valley Water Board may elect to adopt WDRs/NPDES permit that differs from the recommended WDRs/NPDES permit and may do so without another public comment period if determined to be consistent with applicable laws and regulations.
