Ladies and Gentlemen:

We are jointly, as the Dellar Trust and City of Sacramento, requesting a meeting to discuss the status of the site investigation for construction of the proposed modified cap on the former City of Sacramento landfill.

As you know, Tim Crandall of Kleinfelder has been spearheading this site assessment for construction of a modified cap to accommodate numerous FWS-jurisdictional elderberry bushes (i.e. Valley Elderberry Longhorn Beetle; VELB habitat) on the site, while still meeting the Board's directives for site closure. He also performed soil borings within the proposed detention basins.

We would therefore like to review with the Board the results of Tim's soil investigations under and around the elderberry shrubs and within the proposed detention basins and discuss possible requirements for additional fill around or under the elderberry shrubs and disposition of material excavated from the proposed basins as part of this landfill closure.

We commissioned a survey of the entire property as part of the revised grading plan effort and the results suggest that there is very likely debris beyond the boundaries of the Dellar parcel. We will bring a full scale (2x3) of the survey results for your consideration.

Since our last meeting, we have also resolved potential firebreak issues surrounding the elderberry shrubs on the northeast corner of the property with the Sacramento City Fire Department and we can briefly discuss this at our meeting as well.

Lastly, we have identified an opportunity to participate in the CalRecycle Grant Program to assist and defray the expense of construction of the mandated landfill cap. We would therefore like to have a CalRecycle representative at our meeting to discuss the grant fund opportunity in more detail.

We would like to schedule a meeting as soon as possible. We will look forward to hearing from you soon.
