**PUBLIC HEARING**

concerning

Notice of Application for Modification of Waste Discharge Requirements  
(National Pollution Discharge Elimination System Permit No. CA0083861)  
for

**AEROJET ROCKETDYNE, INC.  
SACRAMENTO COUNTY**

Aerojet Rocketdyne, Inc. currently discharges treated groundwater from its Groundwater Extraction and Treatment (GET) Systems to Buffalo Creek, Morrison Creek and the American River in the City of Rancho Cordova. Business activities at the Aerojet facility include development of rocket propulsion systems, engineering, manufacturing and testing, and custom and specialty chemical and pharmaceutical manufacturing and related activities. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board) will consider a minor modification of Aerojet's permit to add an additional groundwater extraction and treatment system to the permit and modify the effluent limitation for cis-1,2-dichloroethene at the GET E/F. The GET AB treatment system is being added and will generally provide its effluent to Aerojet and Teichert for use in their industrial processes. When the demand is reduced from those two users, the discharge from GET AB will go to Buffalo Creek. The effluent limitation for cis-1,2-DCE is being raised to 1.5 µg/L to account for complexities in the GET E/F treatment system that treats for other pollutants such as perchlorate and n-nitrosdimethylamine. The effluent limitation is still below the Primary Drinking Water Standard of 6 µg/L.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed informal hearing item must submit evidence, if any, or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **1 October 2013**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **1 October 2013** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All interested persons may speak at the Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony will be limited in time by the Board Chair.

An objection by a party, either in writing or at the time of the hearing, to the decision to hold an **informal** hearing shall be resolved by the Board Chair before going ahead under the informal procedure. Failure to make a timely objection to the use of informal

hearing procedures before those procedures are used will constitute consent to an informal hearing.
