TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for a proposed wastewater treatment facility in Fresno County that will serve the proposed Friant Ranch master-planned community, the existing Millerton Lake Village Mobile Home Park, and planned future uses of the Friant Community Plan Area. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative WDRs at its 5/6 December 2013 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs must be submitted to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 21 October 2013**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.

In order to conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, a paper copy of the tentative WDRs has been sent only to the Dischargers. Others are advised that the tentative WDRs are available on the Central Valley Water Board's web site at:
