**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

concerning

**RENEWAL OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
(NPDES NO. CA0085278)**

For

**CALAVERAS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

CALAVERAS COUNTY**

Calaveras County Water District is the owner and operator of the Forest Meadows Wastewater Reclamation Plant (Facility), a publicly owned treatment works located at 1040 Forest Meadows Drive, Murphys, California. The Facility provides sewerage services for the community of Forest Meadows, serving a population of approximately 1,200. Treated wastewater is stored and reused for irrigation on the Forest Meadows Golf Course, which is owned and operated by Sierra Golf Management Corp. The golf course reclamation is regulated by Waste Discharge Requirements Order 5-00-066. Due to a lack of sufficient storage capacity during wet years, seasonal discharges from the Facility are authorized under Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2008-0058 (NPDES No. CA0085278), which permits a seasonal discharge (1 December through 15 April) of 0.84 million gallons per day (MGD) of tertiary treated effluent to the Collierville Tunnel that empties into the Stanislaus River, a water of the United States.

The proposed NPDES permit renewal includes new or revised effluent limits for ammonia (as N) and total cyanide (as CN). In addition, the effluent limits for aluminum (total recoverable), total nitrite (as N), foaming agents (MBAS), chlorine residual, and settleable solids have been removed because the discharge does not have reasonable potential to cause or contribute to an exceedance of the applicable water quality objectives for these constituents.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on 2 December 2013. The request must

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explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on 2 December 2013**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **5:00 p.m. on 2 December 2013** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
