NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

MUSCO OLIVE PRODUCTS, INC. DBA MUSCO FAMILY OLIVE COMPANY
AND
THE STUDLEY COMPANY
FOR
MUSCO FAMILY OLIVE COMPANY (TRACY PLANT)
CLASS II SURFACE IMPOUNDMENTS
SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

Musco Olive Products, Inc. owns and operates the Musco Family Olive Company's Tracy Plant (Facility) at 17950 Via Nicolo Road in Tracy. The Facility is on approximately 309 acres of which about 280 acres has been constructed and the remaining 29 acres will be used to construct two new surface impoundments. The waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the Facility are undergoing an update of the current 2005 WDRs Order R5-2005-0024 to address construction of these two new surface impoundments and the closure of an existing surface impoundment. The surface impoundments are used for containment and evaporation of hypersaline wastewater generated from olive processing. The hypersaline solution is characterized as non-hazardous designated waste and as such is regulated under authority given in the Water Code and California Code of Regulations, title 27.

On 13 December 2013, the Discharger submitted an amended Report of Waste Discharge (ROWD). The information in the ROWD has been used in revising these waste discharge requirements. Additionally, the proposed WDRs include time schedules for the Discharger to complete tasks related to constructing the new surface impoundments, clean closing an existing impoundment, and updating financial assurances. Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than noon on **8 September 2014**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements were issued on 8 August 2014. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than by noon on **8 September 2014**. Written materials submitted after 12:00 p.m. on the above date will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
