Dear Ms. Olson:

I had one more comment in regards to the Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements:

1. **Monitoring and Reporting Program R5-:** Please change the monitoring of the secondary effluent from requiring annual testing of the Priority Pollutant List to Standard Minerals as currently listed in our MRP 5-01-124. As you are aware, there is no industry in our service area and therefore no potential for the wide range of constituents as listed in the Priority Pollutant List. If this is not possible, please consider the possibility of lowering the requirement to testing for the Priority Pollutant List to first year of the permit only. If constituent items are detected, continue further annual monitoring for those items plus Standard Mineral monitoring. If not detected revert back to Standard Mineral monitoring only.
