SUBJECT: Placer County Department of Facility Services, Placer County Sewer Maintenance District 3 Wastewater Treatment Plant, Placer County

BOARD ACTION: *Consideration of Rescission of Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2013-0076 (NPDES No. CA0079367) and Rescission of Cease and Desist Order R5-2013-0089*

BACKGROUND: Placer County Department of Facility Services (Discharger) is the owner and operator of Placer County Sewer Maintenance District 3 Wastewater Treatment Plant (Facility) in Placer County, which was permitted to discharge tertiary treated wastewater to Miner's Ravine.

Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order R5-2013-0076 prescribes final effluent limits for the treated wastewater. Cease and Desist Order (CDO) R5-2013-0089 contains interim effluent limits and a compliance schedule to meet final effluent limitations by 31 December 2014. In 2013 and 2014, the Discharger completed work to tie into the City of Roseville collection system so that all wastewater formerly treated at the Facility will be transferred to and treated by the City of Roseville Dry Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant. On 31 December 2014, the discharge to Miner's Ravine ceased. Decommissioning of the Facility was completed on 27 March 2015. The Facility no longer discharges, nor has the ability to discharge, to Miners Ravine, and therefore, it is appropriate to rescind WDR Order R5-2013-0076 (NPDES No. CA0079367) and CDO R5-2013-0089.

ISSUES: A Notice of Public Hearing was sent to the Discharger and interested parties on 13 February 2015 for a 30-day comment period. Written comments are due by 5:00 pm on 15 March 2015.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopted the proposed rescission of WDR Order R5-2013-0076 (NPDES Permit No. CA0079367) and the proposed rescission of CDO R5-2013-0089
