The City of Manteca (City) appreciates the opportunity to comment on the Tentative Order Amending Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2009-0095 (NPDES No. CA0081558) for the City of Manteca Wastewater Quality Control Facility (Tentative Order). The City offers two minor comments on the Tentative Order for consideration.

First, there is an error on page 4, paragraph 3 of the Tentative Order. Table 6 is included in Section IV.A.1.a of Order R5-2009-0095, and Table 7 is included in Section IV.A.2.a. The City requests that this reference be corrected.

The City also requests that the Tentative Order refer to specific pages of Order R5-2009-0005 to avoid any confusion in the future about which sections were amended. The pages could simply be added as parentheticals to the existing section references. For example, paragraph 10 could be revised to state: "Remove the effluent limitation of electrical conductivity in Table F-16 (page F-55), Table F-17 (page F-66), and Table F-18 (page F-68) as shown in ~~strikeout~~ format below"
