Enclosed for your review is a copy of the tentative waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the Folsom Dam Auxiliary Spillway Project in Sacramento County. The enclosed NOPH describes the date, time, and place that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is scheduled to have a hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative WDRs.
