NOTICE TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND PUBLIC HEARING

COUNTY OF KERN FOR POSTCLOSURE MAINTENANCE FOR LOST HILLS SANITARY LANDFILL KERN COUNTY

Enclosed for your review is a copy of the tentative revised waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the Lost Hills Sanitary Landfill. Also enclosed is a notice of public hearing (NOPH) to interested parties, pursuant to §21730 of Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 20005 et seq. (Title 27). The enclosed NOPH describes the date, time, and place that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is scheduled to have a hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative WDRs.
