There is considerable information required in the Ability to Pay Form which I have been working with my CPA to complete for you as well as my bank. The difficulty being that with the modifications, lawsuit and foreclosure I've faced and the loss of Cruiser Haven, filing taxes had not been completed for 2013 to present. Extensions were filed with consideration of these complications. I have been working to remedy this since before our meeting as the same information is needed for my mortgage bank. Due to these complications this is not a simple filing. I have stressed to my CPA that it is very important that I get this wrapped up as quickly as possible. When I initially forwarded the Ability to Pay form to her she said there's no way she would have it in time but I asked her to please try her best. If you like I can send you PDF copies of my bank statements pending completion of the Ability to Pay form.

Updates on the ponds:

Alpha Analytical is coming out on Tuesday to perform the annual testing requirements and we are back on schedule for the testing regiment. I'm upgrading the Pond 1 Aeration pump from a 5HP 3 phase pump to a 7.5 HP 3 phase pump and upgrading the Pond 2 Aeration pump from a 1HP single phase pump to a 5HP 3 phase pump which should reduce ammonia buildup considerably.

Please consider that when I purchased Holland Riverside, Pond 2 was a tulle patch with 4ft tall vegetation growing in the pond and never had any pump at all. I cleaned the ponds up better than they have been since they were built. This 5HP 3 phase aeration pump in pond 2 is a major upgrade to the system. These 3 phase motors are very heavy and expensive. Please take these upgrades into account during my financial evaluation as my mortgage on the marina will remain unpaid in order to facilitate this upgrade.

I have consulted with my bankruptcy attorney in the event I am unable to meet the financial demands required of me. I would prefer to pay for improving the system than facing steep penalties I simply cannot afford and will not benefit the marina or the environment.

I have forwarded your email to my CPA and am working to get this resolved as quickly as possible.

I operate a tractor and machinery often in my daily work. If I do not answer it's likely because I'm operating a John Deere tractor or our diesel mower or maintenance boat. Please leave a message and I will return you're call. The number on my website goes directly to my Harbormaster whom you can also leave a message with.
