
Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs)/NPDES permit for Santa Fe Aggregates, Inc. and Walter John Seaborn (Discharger), Sand and Gravel Plant (Facility) are available for public comment, as explained in the enclosed Notice of Public Hearing. To conserve resources, paper copies of the tentative WDRs/NPDES permit are being sent to the Discharger only. The tentative WDRs/NPDES permit and any additional information are available electronically on the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board's (Central Valley Water Board) web site at:

The Central Valley Water Board has not reviewed or made any decision concerning the tentative WDRs/NPDES permit, which may still be revised following the comment period. Revised documents along with comments and the staff responses will be posted on the above web site and placed in the Central Valley Water Board meeting agenda. The Central Valley Water Board will consider these and any appropriate oral testimony at the scheduled public hearing. The Central Valley Water Board may elect to adopt WDRs/NPDES permit that differ from the recommended WDRs/NPDES permit and may do so without another public comment period if determined to be consistent with applicable laws and regulations.
