Added new Provision **E.242** to General Order ~~Two~~ **Three** regarding applying for salinity exceptions to Basin Plan Water Quality Objectives as implemented by Central Valley Water Board Resolution No. R5 2014-0074. The new provision reads as follows:

**Dischargers may apply for an exception from water quality objectives related to salinity pursuant to Chapter IV, Exception to Discharge Requirements Related to the Implementation of Water Quality Objectives for Salinity, paragraph 8 of the Basin Plan. The application must be made in accordance with Finding No. 54 of this Order and the Discharger must participate in the CV-SALTS Program to qualify for an exception.**
