As you may be aware, the State Water Resources Control Board recently enacted the *Water Quality Control Policy for Siting, Design, Operation, and Maintenance of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems* (OWTS Policy, see: http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/water_issues/programs/owts/docs/owts_policy.pdf). The OWTS Policy gives Local Agencies an option to submit Local Agency Management Programs (LAMPs). The Yolo County Environmental Health Director has recently submitted a LAMP for approval by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) at the upcoming August 2016 Meeting; see the attached, and our website: http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/centralvalley/board_decisions/tentative_orders/index.shtml.
