TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative Resolution to approve the Storm Water Management Plan for the State of California, Department of Parks and Recreation, Carnegie State Vehicle Recreation Area in Alameda and San Joaquin counties. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the tentative Resolution must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 21 November 2011**. Written materials submitted after this date and time will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative Resolution will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Resolution at its 1-2 December 2011 Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed.

By 1 November 2011 post one (1) copy of the Notice of Public Hearing at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse;
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by 10 November 2011. To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative document to the discharger only.
