TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative Order Amending Order R5-2005-0040, Master Reclamation Permit for the City of Lincoln. Any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the tentative Order should be submitted to this office no later than 5:00 p.m. on **20 February 2012** in order for us to give them full consideration prior to the meeting of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board).

A Notice of Public Hearing (Notice) concerning the tentative Order is also enclosed. Regulations require that the Discharger post the Notice by **20 January 2011**. One (1) copy of the Notice must be posted at the nearest city hall or county courthouse, one (1) copy at the post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed), and one (1) copy at the public entrance to the wastewater treatment plant. Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **31 January 2012**.

In order to conserve resources, this letter transmits paper copies of the documents to the Discharger only.
