**NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT FOR PENALTIES
IN THE MATTER OF
DONNER SUMMIT PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT
NEVADA COUNTY**

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) proposes to enter into a settlement with the Donner Summit Public Utilities District (Discharger) for alleged violations of the Federal Clean Water Act. The Discharger is alleged to have violated effluent and receiving water limitations, and the Central Valley Water Board proposes a penalty of \$49,000 for these violations. The public is invited to comment on this settlement by submitting written comments to the below address, attention Patricia Leary, by 5 pm on 30 December 2008.
