After a 30-day public comment period, the Central Valley Regional Water Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) will consider issuing a Notice of Applicability (NOA) of General Order R5-2003-0044 (General Order) to Red Barn, Discharger, for proposed groundwater cleanup. This letter serves as our request for public comments.
