REQUIREMENT TO DEVELOP GROUNDWATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Thank you for the timely submittal of the East San Joaquin Water Quality Coalition's (Coalition) Groundwater Quality Assessment Report, as required by the Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) General Order R5-2012-0116-R1. The Coalition's Groundwater Quality Assessment Report and tentatively designated high vulnerability areas are under Central Valley Water Board staff review.

A Groundwater Quality Management Plan must be developed for high vulnerability areas determined as part of the Groundwater Quality Assessment Report process. Please note that once the Executive Officer has approved of or made changes to the high vulnerability designations, the Coalition will have **60 days** to prepare a Groundwater Quality Management Plan (WDR, sections VIII.H.1 and VIII.H.2). The Groundwater Quality Management Plan will have to meet requirements described in WDR Attachment B, Appendix MRP-1, and the draft management plan will be posted for a public review and comment period.
