NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD PROPOSED SURFACE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR CHANAC CREEK

The public and interested stakeholders are invited to submit comments on the proposed Surface Water Quality Management Plan (SQMP) for Chanac Creek submitted by the Kern River Watershed Coalition Authority (Coalition) on 30 November 2015. A link to the document can be found below. The Coalition is currently approved under Waste Discharge Requirements General Order R5-2013-0120 (General Order) to serve as a third-party entity representing owners and operators of irrigated lands located within the Tulare Lake Basin Area. The General Order requires that Coalitions representing growers develop SQMPs for monitoring sites where there is an exceedance of a water quality objective or trigger limit more than one time in a three-year period.
