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U.S. BUREAU OF RECLAMATION: DRAFT 2017 ANNUAL WORK PLAN,
OCTOBER 1, 2016 – SEPTEMBER 30, 2017

On 16 May 2016, we received the Bureau of Reclamation Management Agency Agreement (MAA) *Draft Annual Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2017*, as required under the December 2014 MAA between our two agencies (Resolution R5-2014-0150). The purpose of the annual work plans is to identify specific activities that Reclamation plans to implement during the coming federal fiscal year (October 2016 through September 2017) to manage and mitigate salinity impacts to the Lower San Joaquin River Basin.

On 17 May 2016, we posted the Draft Annual Work Plan on our website for public review and comment, on behalf of Reclamation. Comments were due on 20 June 2016. One comment letter was received from Stockton East Water District (SEWD) in addition to comments from my staff. On 6 July 2016, Reclamation provided responses to staff and SEWD comments in a spreadsheet-matrix format, and on 26 July 2016 Reclamation submitted the Final 2017 Annual Work Plan.

As the Central Valley Water Board's Executive Officer, I accept the Final 2017 Annual Work Plan on behalf of the Central Valley Water Board per the authority provided in Resolution R5-2014-0150.
