On 7 November 2014 the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) posted a Notice of Public Hearing announcing that it would consider resolutions to approve revisions to an existing Management Agency Agreement (MAA) with the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) and a Real Time Salinity Management (RTMP) framework document for the Lower San Joaquin River at the 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> December 2014 Central Valley Water Board meeting. Both documents reference Annual Work Plans developed by the USBR, with the draft of the first work plan due for public review and comment by 31 October 2014. Furthermore, the revised MAA requires that the final Annual Work Plan be submitted by 31 December 2014 to the Central Valley Water Board after a public review and comment period.

The Central Valley Water Board has posted the first draft Annual Work Plan, dated 31 October 2014, on the Central Valley Water Board website for public review and comment. The website address is:
